



Minor Officials

- Facilities should sanitize the minor officials box and equipment prior to each use
- Minor officials shall wear masks, should have sanitizer
- Home will provide up to 3 minor officials, visitors do not provide any
 - o Facilities may have a maximum, in those cases, that is to be followed
- Shot clock may move to other areas, if necessary, and only after communication with an on-ice official
- Players will enter and exit penalty boxes on their own
 - o Use verbal communication to cue the players, or remind them to close the door properly
- On-ice officials will put on their masks if communication is not possible at a distance
- On-ice officials may direct or ask for the game sheet to be lifted up to the glass or provide instructions on filling out the game sheet, to limit touch points
- Avoid using the hole in the glass for communication, use doors if necessary
 - o Use sanitizer if needing to open/close the door
- Avoid sharing roles, limit contact points

NOTE: Minor officials are NOT part of the cohorts.

****Facility Protocols should be followed and may be more restrictive than stated.**
