



Officials Attestations

While the RAMP TeamApp works great for players and coaches on teams, officials are also part of the cohort and need to complete the health attestation. Including officials on the TeamApp is not possible. Ringette Alberta asks teams, minor officials, and on-ice officials to work together to complete attestations for the cohort.

Please adhere to the following for each cohort:

1. On-ice officials must complete the attestation 24-0 hrs before the game
 - a. The on-ice official may bring a copy already printed
 - b. Teams should always have blank copies available
2. Minor officials from the home team must collect these forms from the officials
 - a. From the officials' room (wear a mask)
 - b. From the officials when at the timekeepers box
3. Home team must keep forms for 30 days

IMPORTANT things to remember:

- Officials are required to complete the attestation
- Date and time of event are needed
- Home team must collect these forms
- Home team must keep forms for 30 days
- When unable to physically distance from officials to collect the form, all individuals must be wearing a mask
- Officials should keep extra copies in their bag with a pen
- Teams should keep extra copies with them
