Canada Winter Games Information

Ringette was first introduced into the Canada Winter Games in 1991. Held every four years, the Canada Winter Games are a key event in the development of Canada's young athletes. As the best in their age group, these young competitors come to the Games having trained long and hard to be among those chosen to represent their respective province or territory and compete for the Canada Games Flag and Centennial Cup. With the Canada Games poised as a key step in the development of Canada's future stars, Canada Games athletes are Canada's next generation Junior and Senior National team athletes. In Ringette, the Canada Games is an opportunity for Learn to Win stage athletes to compete as part of their provincial team. The level of play is AAA and a stepping-stone towards international level competition.

The 2023 Canada Winter Games will take place in February, in Prince Edward Island. Team Alberta will be comprised of 18 highly skilled athletes, born 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006, selected from Camps between April and September 2022.

Ringette Alberta is looking for one head coach and two or three assistant coaches to lead our 2023 Team Alberta.

TEAM STAFF REQUIREMENTS

Note: Four coaches are permitted on the bench, and one of HC/AC must be female.

Head Coach/Assistant Coach

- Minimum of 3 years (HC) or 2 years (AC) coaching experience at U19AA or higher
- Competition Development Certified strongly preferred
- Making Head Way in Sport module
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders OR the Coaching Association of Canada's Safe Sport module
- Making Ethical Decisions complete

Coach-in-Training (CIT)/Women in Training (WIT) Apprenticeship Program

- Ringette Alberta would have to apply for credentials and there are limited spots so this may not be possible.
- Coach would work alongside Team Staff throughout the CWG program.
- Coaching U16AA or higher.
- Must be working towards Competition Development training – completed 4 of 8 multi-sport modules at time of application.
